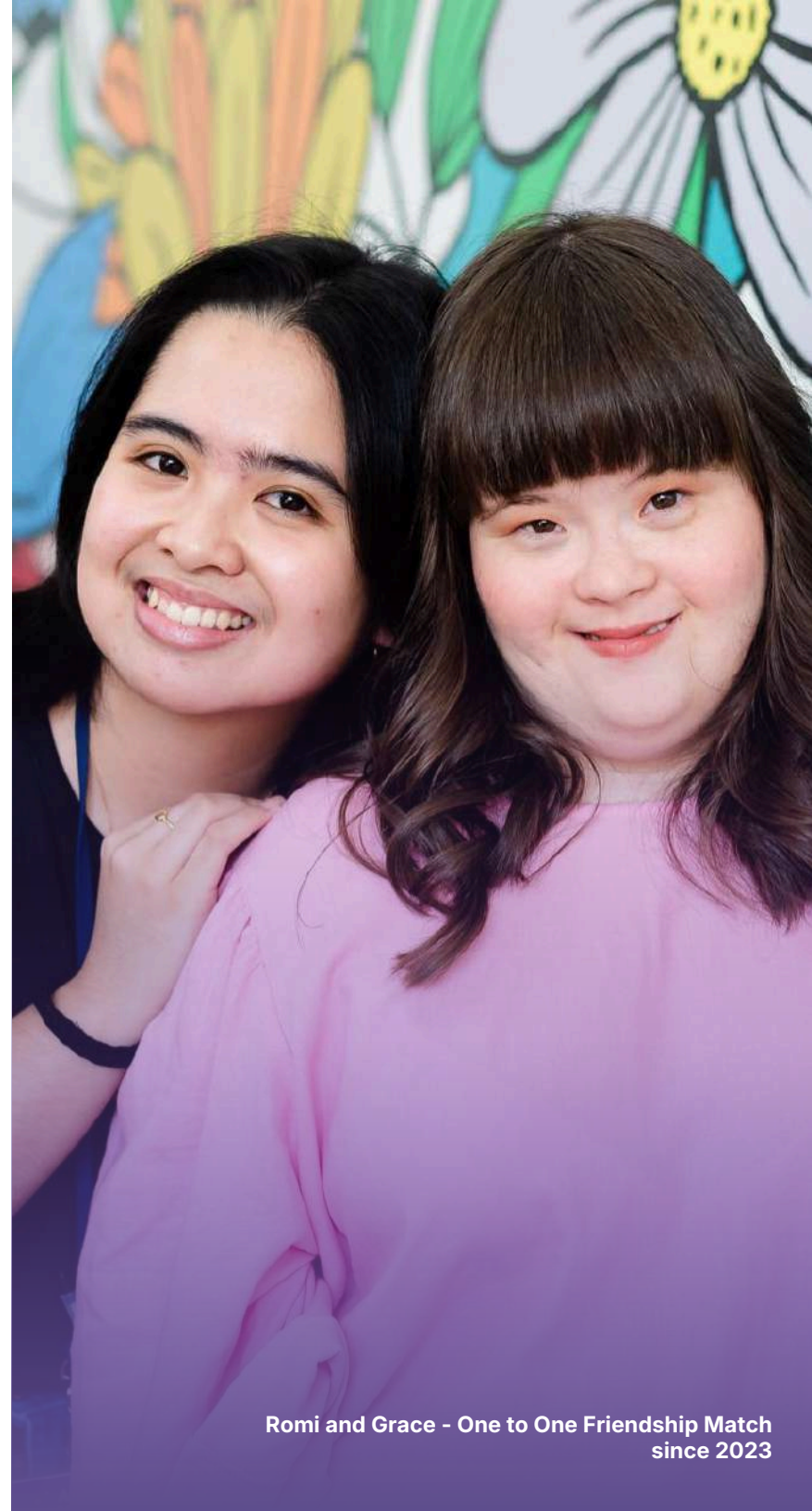

This is where Best Buddies all over the globe plays a vital role as a model of inclusion and catalyst for change. Best Buddies is the world's largest organization committed to ending the social, physical and economic isolation that 200 million individuals with IDD often experience. For those within the IDD community, Best Buddies represents a pathway to forging lifelong friendships, securing gainful employment, achieving independent living and gaining the skills and confidence to advocate for themselves.

Parent's Perspective

Charmane Kanahashi is a lawyer and a dedicated officer of the Board of Trustees of Best Buddies Philippines, where she actively advocates for inclusion, dignity, and meaningful opportunities for persons with intellectual and developmental diversities (not disabilities). More importantly and beyond her professional and advocacy roles, she is the proud mother to Carlos, a person with autism. Her personal journey as a parent deeply shapes her commitment to advancing awareness, acceptance, and policies that support individuals with autism and their families. Through both her legal expertise and lived experience, she brings compassion, insight, and purpose to her service with Best Buddies Philippines.

"It has been a source of pride and fulfillment to share with younger mothers of persons with autism my son's achievements, particularly obtaining a real estate management college degree. At first, they couldn't believe it was even possible to finish high school, more so get a college degree and be gainfully employed! I'm glad our story gives them hope.

Like these younger moms, I have always been worried and anxious about what the future holds for my son. It's a mother's job to worry but it's more important to be your child's source of strength. We can't just worry. We must believe in what they can do and let them thrive. We must trust them.

Serving on the Board of Trustees of Best Buddies Philippines is both a professional commitment and a deeply personal one. As a lawyer and as the mother of my son Carlos, who is on the autism spectrum, I am guided by love, lived experience, and a strong belief in inclusion—so that persons with autism are not only supported, but truly seen, valued, celebrated, and empowered."

2025 Highlights

Part of ADCOM

BBP has been selected to be part of the Advisory Committee (ADCOM) on the Implementation of R.A. 11650. Official Oath-Taking was conducted on May 4, 2025. Through the ADCOM, BBP has formed valuable relationships with staunch advocates of inclusive education, including educators, therapists, other non-government organizations, parents, and stakeholders.

Year Long Delivery of Training

BBP administered 28 trainings, rendering over 50 training hours for student interns, volunteers, corporate partners, collaborators, and co-advocates. These trainings were facilitated via Zoom or onsite in order to equip partners with the necessary knowledge, skills, and information that will enable them to interact, communicate, and engage with young adults with autism, Down syndrome, learning disabilities, etc.

PARTNERSHIPS: Collaboration Opportunities with Partners

Best Buddies partnered with BAYO Philippines and Adidas Philippines for Inclusive Employment Opportunities. This also includes the Inclusive Fashion Show LAMINA in collaboration with Manila Art and Bayo Foundation, Inc.

INTEGRATED EMPLOYMENT: Pre-Employment Batch 2

Best Buddies facilitated the Batch 2 of Pre-Employment Participants for young adults with autism, brain injury and intellectual disability. This facet of the Employment Program allowed BBP to work closely with corporate partners by first training their employees before volunteering for their scheduled PEP Session.

Onboarding Phase 1 Participants for Adidas Employment

Together with Adidas, we prepared Jobs Candidates, HR, middle management, and team leaders for the integrated work process. Collaborating, assessing, and providing accommodations and adjustments as the first round of neurodiverse team members set the stage for future Jobs Candidates to take their place in other stores around Metro Manila.

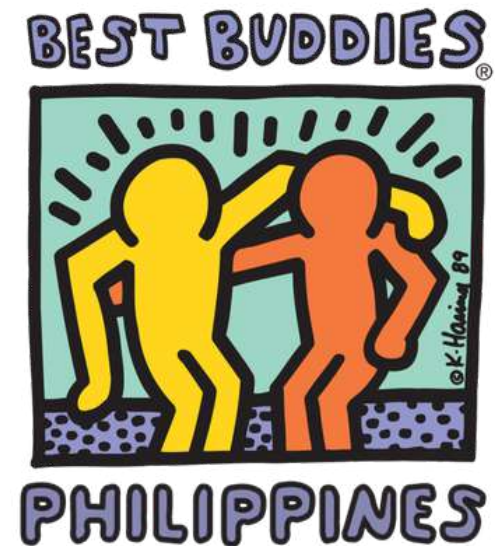

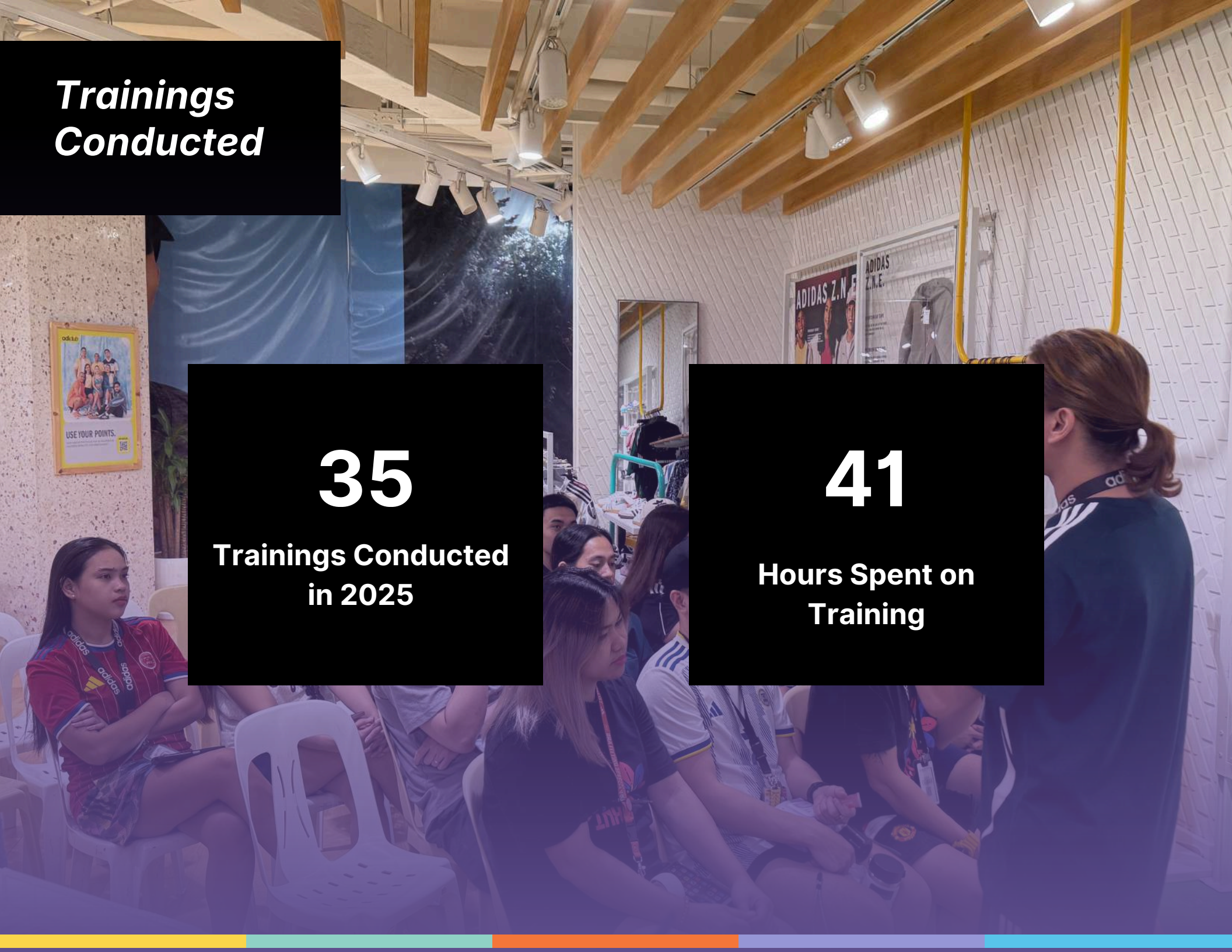

We are BEST BUDDIES®

Best Buddies is the largest organization dedicated to ending the social, physical, and economic isolation of the 200 million people worldwide with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). Our programs empower people with IDD to form meaningful friendships with their peers, secure jobs, improve communication and advocacy skills, and live independently, while also offering support for their families.

Mission

Best Buddies International is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to establishing a global volunteer movement that creates opportunities for one-to-one friendships, integrated employment, leadership development, inclusive living, and family support for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD).

Who We Serve

Best Buddies Philippines serves individuals with IDD and their families. The IDD community includes, but is not limited to, people with Down syndrome, autism, Fragile X, Williams syndrome, and other undiagnosed disabilities.

One-To-One Friendships

Builds friendships between people with and without IDD, offering social mentoring while improving the quality of life and level of inclusion for a population that is often isolated and excluded.

Friendship Chapters

Empowers youth to become advocates for people with IDD and helps chapters organize special events that promote inclusion and bring awareness to the disability rights movement.



Integrated Employment

Secures jobs for people with IDD, empowering them to earn an income, pay taxes, and independently support themselves through their professional accomplishments.

Matches skilled, qualified individuals with IDD with businesses seeking enthusiastic and dedicated employees. Through the Jobs program, Best Buddies develops partnerships with employers, assists with the hiring process and provides ongoing support to the employee and employer.



Family Support

Provides families access to individual connections and community resources that assist them on their journey of supporting a family member with IDD.

Connects families who are expecting or have a young child with IDD to experienced parents of a child with IDD, encouraging a genuine relationship rooted in mentorship, resource-sharing, and guidance.



Leadership Development

Educates and empowers people with and without IDD to become leaders, public speakers, and advocates.

BBP Ambassadors

Offers people with and without IDD the opportunity to gain the public speaking skills, self-esteem, and confidence needed to successfully advocate for themselves, their peers, and Best Buddies in communities and workplaces.

One-to-One Friendships

Without love, support, and friends, life may feel isolating – this is a reality people with IDD have faced throughout history. Best Buddies offers people with IDD the chance to have a friend, gain self-confidence and self-esteem and share interests, experiences, and activities that many other individuals enjoy.

Friendship Chapters

Empowers youth to become advocates for people with IDD and helps chapters organize special events that promote inclusion and bring awareness to the disability rights movement.

BESTBUDDIES® Elementary Schools, Middle Schools, High Schools & Colleges

Offers students with IDD the opportunity to have a friend and enjoy common interests, experiences, and social activities in the Middle School, High School, and College programs. Each friendship pair commits to speaking and spending time together every week throughout the year. These programs create lasting friendships and help facilitate an environment of inclusion throughout the school and in the community.

BESTBUDDIES® Citizens

For people with IDD, the absence of meaningful friendships extends into adulthood. Best Buddies Citizens pairs adults with IDD in one-to-one friendships with adults without IDD in corporate and civic communities. Citizen buddy pairs commit to a one-year friendship in which they will talk once a week and see each other twice a month. These relationships commonly grow into friendships that last a lifetime.

One-To-One Friendships

On December 14, 2024, Andie and Alex met for the first time through the Best Buddies PH Friendship matching program. When they first met at the Best Buddies BSM Christmas Hangout, they instantly clicked; they shared similar hobbies and interests, and both loved Sanrio characters. This event marked the beginning of a year-long friendship.

Through various hangouts, planned by both the Best Buddies PH Organization and the Best Buddies BSM chapter, Andie and Alex have formed a wonderful friendship through fun activities such as: cookie and ornament decorating in the 2024 Christmas hangout; shared journal, from the matching party, where they created doodles of Sanrio characters; the Xylo at The Palace: Haunted Hangout where they talked and danced together on the dance floor. These experiences have deepened Andi's understanding of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and have inspired her to take on a leadership role to positively influence others within the BSM community.

Through the Best Buddies Friendship Program, Andie and Alex have blossomed and positively influenced others within the chapter, helping doubling recruitment and friendship matches made for the 2025-2026 school year.

Integrated Employment

Best Buddies Jobs assists participants in finding meaningful employment, earning a competitive income, receiving benefits, and working alongside others in the community. The program offers people with IDD the opportunity to become financially independent, removing the need for government assistance or parental support. A focus on competitive, professional opportunities is what sets the Best Buddies Jobs program apart from other employment services.

Pre Employment Program

Creates opportunity for reinforced learning with job seeking skills at the forefront of the program. Through a twelve session module in partnership with potential employers, participants are taken through lessons that incorporate resume writing, application process, interviewing skills, and exploratory STEAM lessons.

Participants are presented with opportunities for immersions, internship (OJT) placements, and employment opportunities.

The focus is on creating competitive opportunities for integrated job placements that allow participants to earn an income, pay taxes. With Best Buddies supports in place, Jobs Participants can work in an environment alongside their peers in the community, leading to full inclusion and independence.

Coaching is provided and BBP Employment Consultants liaise between the participant, HR, supervisors, and even family members to provide the greatest avenue for success and retention

Integrated Employment

Coji was diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder at an early age and required support in communication and routine. Through consistent occupational and speech therapy, he gradually developed essential social and communication skills. He attended SPED classes during preschool and later enrolled at Integrated Movement Academy Inc. (IMAI), and significant turning point occurred when he joined the Best Buddies community in 2015.

Through Best Buddies, Coji experienced meaningful friendships, gained a sense of belonging, and grew in confidence. He became a Best Buddies ambassador in 2017, transforming from a shy child into a confident individual who readily connects with others.

During the pandemic, Coji remained actively engaged through virtual activities and completed additional ambassador training in 2022. In 2024, he participated in Best Buddies' job training and pre-employment programs, including the Microsoft Enabler Program, with the goal of entering the workforce. His determination led to an interview and eventual employment with Adidas.

Today, Coji works as a part-time Retail Associate at Adidas Brand Center, where he confidently interacts with coworkers and customers, attends meetings, and contributes to sales. His journey reflects how inclusive programs, strong family support, and community partnerships can empower individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to thrive, belong, and succeed independently.

Leadership Development

Best Buddies educates and empowers people with and without IDD to become leaders, public speakers and change agents. Through the Ambassadors and Promoters programs, participants inspire their communities to build a more inclusive world for people with IDD.

BESTBUDDIES® Ambassadors

are participants with and without IDD trained in speech writing, public speaking, and self-advocacy. Ambassadors develop the skills to share their life stories, promote Best Buddies programs, network, and, most importantly, advocate. Ambassadors participate in trainings focused on the art of public speaking and advocacy. Once trained, they share their stories and become more involved and empowered as citizens. Ambassadors are encouraged to speak about opportunities for people with IDD, present at recruitment fairs and Best Buddies events, and develop partnerships in the community.

BESTBUDDIES® Promoters

empowers the youth to become advocates for people with IDD by organizing and attending special events that promote inclusion. Students attending a school without a special education program can join a Promoters chapter to develop connections with people with IDD or can start one by contacting their local Best Buddies state office. Each Promoters chapter is led by a chapter president from the student body and a faculty advisor and is assigned a Best Buddies staff person who offers regular support and guidance. Once formed, Promoters chapters host events, activities, and fundraisers where they advocate for people with IDD, and promote the Best Buddies mission.

"My name is Carlos Francisco. When I was three years old, I was diagnosed with Autism. Instead of letting that diagnosis bring limits, my family and the supportive members of my community helped me discover my strengths, my confidence, my voice, and my purpose in who I was meant to be. Even with support, there were times where I felt different, misunderstood, or unsure of where I belonged. In 2023, I joined Best Buddies, and that decision opened a chapter of my life I never imagined.

Through Best Buddies, I wasn't just welcomed, I was embraced. I found people who understood me, uplifted me, and believed in me. Later on, I stepped into the role of a Best Buddies Ambassador, a role that transformed my life. Becoming an ambassador didn't just give me a title. It gave me purpose. It helped me step out of my shell and brought me to places where I was needed. It also gave me the opportunity to meet new people from around the world that I never thought I'd connect with such as mentors, leaders, fellow ambassadors, and new friends.

These friendships were unexpected, genuine, and life-changing. They taught me that leadership isn't about having all the answers, it's about having the heart to show up, share your story, and create friendships built on understanding and respect. All the challenges I faced shaped me into who I am today, and helped me grow into a leader and a friend to others. I'm still writing my story, but I know that: I am learning. I am growing. And I am becoming someone who isn't afraid to step forward, speak out, and shine."

Family Support

Best Buddies Family Support offers families the support and resources needed to navigate the journey of raising a child with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD).

Eunie's BUDDIES®

Eunie's Buddies serves as the pioneering program within the Family Support initiative. It is named affectionately in honor of Eunice Kennedy Shriver, founder of Special Olympics and a true hero who advocated tirelessly for positive change in the lives of individuals with IDD.

Eunie's Buddies pairs experienced parents of a child with an IDD with new parents who are expecting, have just welcomed a baby, or are raising a child up to the age of eight years old who has been recently diagnosed with an IDD. This pairing creates a mentor-mentee connection and friendship.

Eunie's Buddies provides a framework offering parents and caregivers encouragement, emotional support, and valuable resources. Participation in Eunie's Buddies helps families pave the way for a child with IDD to have an education, gainful employment, and a fulfilled life.

International Programs

In 2024, the newly formed International Programs and Incubator Teams set out to strengthen global Best Buddies operations through expanded funding opportunities, strategic guidance, social media support, and training. Their primary goal was to deepen the impact of country programs by aligning efforts and resources, especially in areas of employment programming, operational development, and donor engagement.
